If your WI would like to make use of the HFWI IFEs' services, you should ask your members to approve the appointment of a WI trained "Independent Examiner" at your next Meeting and return the request slip below to WI House.

There is a fee of £20 for this service plus any expenses (such as postage or travel) incurred by the Independent Examiner. After completion of audit an invoice will be sent from HFWI who will then forward payment to the respective IFE. Any IFE, who is a Trustee, does not receive payment, their fee will be retained by Herefordshire Federation of Women's Institutes. (Enclosure: IFE28NOV2023)

REVIEW OF NFWI ANNUAL MEETINGS

NFWI have informed us of the outcome of their review of NAMs. In 2024 the NAM will be held on 5 June at the Royal Albert Hall, London. Observer tickets will be priced at £28 per ticket and NFWI will also offer a free to view streaming service from the Royal Albert Hall for those who wish to join online. Unlike previous Annual Meetings where observers have paid to view online, these links will be circulated free of charge.

From 2025 NFWI will begin a continuous three-year cycle, that will include two consecutive meetings that will offer online participation only, followed by one in-person meeting at a larger venue, allowing members to join both in-person and online. The delegate ratio for the online meetings in 2025 and 2026 has been set as 1:4. The delegate ratio for the hybrid meeting in 2027 will be decided later once the venue is known.
