The castle houses a fantastic collection of South Asian objects in the Clive Museum (Clive of India) as well as other fantastic displays. The gardens are outstanding with 30-foot-high cloud hedges, 17th century Italianate terraces and wonderful views across the Severn Valley. BIG PLASTIC CLEAN-UP

Julia works at an organisation called Everyday Plastic. They run campaigns to raise awareness about the single-use plastic problem and aim to inspire people to reduce their own plastic consumption. This March, they're teaming up with Greenpeace UK to run <u>The Big Plastic Count</u>, the UK's largest investigation into household plastic waste. Their goal is to highlight the urgency and scale of the plastic problem and empower individuals to play a part in helping solve the plastic crisis.
