Starting 17th Feb, this is a month-long collaboration with Anya to celebrate the rich history of the WI, All shops will have their facades yarn bombed and one of the shops' interiors will have all the banners covering the walls. There will also be a small collection of bags that will be dual branded. These will be sold only in the shops, not online.
